- I. Has it been at least 6 months since your Date
 Of Entry (DOE) into the **CO National Guard** and
 have you been actively serving the entire time?
- 2. Are you satisfactorily performing as a CO
 National Guard member, including passing PT
 scares, n□ counseling, and have no flags on your
 file?
- 3. Ones your Expiration Term of Service (ETS) end after the last day of your semester?
- 4. On you currently have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (CGPA) **or** are you a brand new student and have never attended college before?

If you answered YES to <u>ALL</u> the questions above, you may be eligible to apply!

Frequently Asked Questions

D. What does State Tuiti□nAssistance caver?

A. In-state Tuitinonly (after the ColoradoOpportunity Fund (COF) stipend is applied).COF not available at all State schools.State TA does not caver fees, booksor living expenses.

Funds are only issued to schools, not applicants.

D. Is there a cap an haw much State TA I can receive in a semester/ trimester?

A. Yes. Up ta \$5.000 per semester/trimester. Awards based an funding availability, subject ta change.

D. If I apply for CO National Guard State Tuition
Assistance and Federal Tuition Assistance
(GOARMYEO), can I use bath sources ta pay for my
sch□□ling? What about my GI Bill?

A. Yes. in mast cases.Be aware that CO National Guard State Tuitin Assistance will always be applied !awards your tuition balance first. Yau can apply far Federal TA (GOARMYEO) your remaining tuition balance.

Or you can apply for GI Bill funding. Chpt.1606/1607 GI Bill funding and Federal TA (GOARMYED) cannot be used simultaneously far the same courses.
